Presentations

The date and time for all presenters to meet online (via MS Teams) to present their paper will be communicated in the conference programme. Guidance for the online meetings will follow soon. Note that we advise you to record yourself doing your presentation and that you send it to the conference organizers ahead of time (DiedericksA@cput.ac.za). This will allow for a back-up should you have load shedding or internet issues.
